

## SCHOOL UNIFORM

The uniform for Years 7 to 9 available from El Corte Inglés is as follows:

### **Girls:**

- Navy blue culottes (knee length) or
- Navy blue tailored trousers

### **Boys:**

- Navy blue tailored trousers or shorts
- (Please note that no jeans or navy-blue tracksuit bottoms are accepted.)

*Trousers for both girls and boys, and culottes for girls, **must** be the ones sold at the uniform department in El Corte Inglés.*

### **Girls and Boys:**

- Green sweatshirt with navy blue and red bands
- Red turtle-neck jumper, under the sweatshirt or the school T-shirt in winter
- Navy socks or tights
- Completely black/ completely navy-blue shoes (the soles and the shoe laces should also be completely black or navy blue and have no colourful logos)

### Physical Education:

- Navy track suit with green and red bands
- Green T-shirt with navy blue and red bands
- Navy shorts with green and red bands
- Navy or white socks
- Trainers

**Summer Uniform (P.E. shorts with the corresponding P.E. zip-up jacket) may be worn from 1st May to the end of June and in the whole month of September even on non-P.E. days. Shorts should be worn with the corresponding P.E. zip-up jacket and NOT the uniform jumper.**

**ACCESSORIES:** *Any accessories, e.g. earrings, belts and bracelets must be discreet as befitting a private educational establishment. No dangly earrings are permitted. Only small hoop earrings are permitted. Hairstyles should also be*



*discreet. Scarves may not be worn in the classroom.*

### **Dress code for non-uniform days**

Students should come as well-dressed as possible, although casual clothing may be worn. As the concept of dress can vary according to the perception and personal taste of each person, please follow this series of indications:

1. If leggings are worn, a shirt, blouse, or sweatshirt must sufficiently cover legs (approximately half-way down the leg).
2. Jeans should be respectable and should have no rips, holes, and should not be worn too low.
3. Garments that are transparent, very tight, very short (no hot-pant style shorts) or very low-cut at the neck cannot be worn. Crop tops should NOT be worn and no midriffs on show.
4. Clothes must not have inappropriate symbols or messages.
5. If pupils have P.E. on the non-uniform day, suitable clothes and footwear must be worn.

If anyone is seen wearing inappropriate clothing, they will receive a note in their diary and they will be unable to participate in the next non-uniform day. An appropriate sanction will also be given.
