

## SCHOOL UNIFORM

The uniform for Years 10 and 11 available from El Corte Inglés is as follows for boys and girls:

1. **Navy blue sweatshirt** with the school logo.
2. **Navy tee shirt**, also bearing the school logo, with a white neck and wide sleeve.
3. Pupils may wear the usual navy skirt/trousers of the school uniform or standard dark navy-blue jeans (no torn or flashily accessorized and studded versions) with the sweatshirt and/or tee shirt. Knee length jeans may be worn in the summer.
4. Completely black/ completely navy-blue shoes (the soles and the shoe laces should also be completely black or navy blue and have no colourful logos) and navy blue socks.
5. In cold weather pupils may wear a navy blue, long-sleeved polo-neck shirt.
6. **The Physical Education uniform** is a navy tracksuit with the school logo, the navy tee shirt with the school logo and navy shorts with green and red stripes, navy or white socks and trainers.

Please note this tracksuit will continue to be obligatory up to and including Year 12.

**Summer Uniform (P.E. shorts with the corresponding P.E. zip-up jacket) may be worn from 1st May to the end of June and in the whole month of September even on non-P.E. days. P.E. shorts should be worn with the corresponding P.E. zip-up jacket and NOT the uniform jumper.**

**Accessories:** Any accessories, e.g. makeup, earrings, belts and bracelets must be discreet as befitting a private educational establishment. No dangly earrings are permitted. Only small hoop earrings are permitted. Hairstyles should also be discreet. Scarves may not be worn in the classroom.



When purchasing the items bearing the school logo at El Corte Inglés, please make sure that you specify it is for 3º and 4º E.S.O.

### **Dress code for non-uniform days**

Students should come as well-dressed as possible, although casual clothing may be worn. As the concept of dress can vary according to the perception and personal taste of each person, please follow this series of indications:

1. If leggings are worn, a shirt, blouse, or sweatshirt must sufficiently cover legs (approximately half-way down the leg).
2. Jeans should be respectable and should have no rips, holes, and should not be worn too low.
3. Garments that are transparent, very tight, very short (no hot-pant style shorts) or very low-cut at the neck cannot be worn. Crop tops should NOT be worn and no midriffs on show.
4. Clothes must not have inappropriate symbols or messages.
5. If pupils have P.E. on the non-uniform day, suitable clothes and footwear must be worn.

If anyone is seen wearing inappropriate clothing, they will receive a note in their diary and they will be unable to participate in the next non-uniform day. An appropriate sanction will also be given.
