

too. Some of the principles are children are free to move around the classroom and that students get to choose from a wide range of activities. Montessori approach is generally more progressive than standard education and has a very good success rate.



Clash Royale: Probably the most popular mobile game at the moment, it's a fun game to play in your free time, and it's easy to get good at after awhile. Platforms: Mobile






MOVIE REVIEW

wonder Woman is a 2017 superhero movie based off the iconic character by DC Comics. The plot revolves around Amazonian princess, Diana (a.k.a Wonder Woman), who becomes embroiled in WW1 after an American spy, Steve Trevor, crashlands outside her island. The film has received both critical and commercial success, but is is worthy of its success? (SPOILER ALERT)

The film does many things right. It has a likable, charismatic protagonist, the dialogue scenes between Diana and Steve Trevor are excellent, and the film has a generally light-hearted tone, unlike previous DC movies. In regards to the characters, Wonder Woman is a league above many superhero films. The costuming, sets and locations are brilliant, and some of the action scenes are astonishing (e.g. the trench scene). However, plot-wise, the movie falters. The story is very simple, and while it attempts to have big themes, it fails at them. One of the biggest problems with Wonder Woman, is the villain, Ares. The whole movie we're led up to believe that German commander Ludendorff is Ares. and for good reasons. He wants to continue the war, he has some weird potion with him, and knows a lot about Greek mythology. But in a cheap twist, it turns out Ares is someone in the British war council. This twist makes little sense, and just ruins the villain. In the climax, Diana fights against Ludendorff, and eventually kills him.







However, she looks around and sees that the men haven't stopped fighting. This in my opinion would have been a great way to end the movie. One theme the film alludes to, is that of human morality. Diana thinks humans are good by nature, while Steve thinks all humans have good and bad qualities in them. This alternate ending would have her realise Steve was right, and would have completed Diana's story arc and evolved her character. It would also have been a surprise to the viewer. It would have completed the story in a meaningful way, and made it a truly great film. Sadly, this was not the actual ending. Turns out Ludendorff wasn't Ares, is was some other guy. and Diana has a cliché boss fight with him, full of bad effects and harmless punching. Diana then kills Ares, and the war magically ends. Yes we get a mildly entertaining fight, but this means the movie isn't as good as it could be. In the end, it was an entertaining film with likable characters, but it has conflicting themes, forgettable villains, and a protagonist that doesn't change throughout the movie. It's an averagely good film, but it's a disappointment nonetheless, because it could have been much more.













Word bank butterfly - chameleon - ladybug - toucan



Thankfully, in Madrid we are lucky to have a wonderful planetarium. The domeshaped building has many exhibitions, school visits and workshops inside. It was introduced in 1986 and during 2016 and 2017 it went under renovation which changed the building completely. Throughout the school year, schools can visit the planetarium and in one year alone the amount of school children that visit can reach up to 60,000 students. the visit is guided by supervisors both through the exhibition and the video room.

In October students from year 4 went to visit the planetarium. Inside they saw a movie that was described by one of the students as "so funny (...)". Many of the students liked the movie. the movie was about a vampire that could not see the stars because the clouds were covering them, so he made a giant telescope that could reach into space. "I loved the movie because characters were so funny,"

said Sabrina. There was also an exhibition about a big ice cube that represented temperature which students could touch with there bare hands. Pablo from year 4 Gemma's class found it so interesting. "The ice cube was so big and when I touched it I couldn't believe how cold it was," remarked Pablo.


